Facility Pass Information

All residents of Providence will have 7 opportunities to obtain a facility pass. Passes will be issued in the Providence Clubhouse on the following dates:

Saturday	May 07, 2016	9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Saturday	May 14, 2016	9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Tuesday	May 24, 2016	7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.
Monday	May 30, 2016	9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

****Passes will not be issued after the last scheduled session on May 30, 2016 ****

A facility pass is required to use the swimming pool, tennis courts and the clubhouse. Residents must be in possession of a pass when using the Providence facilities and are required to show their pass upon request.

A PROPERTY OWNER WHO IS DELINQUENT IN THEIR ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS OR HAS ANY BALANCE DUE WILL NOT BE ISSUED A FACILITY PASS NOR MAY THEY OBTAIN A TENNIS COURT KEY.

Those residents requesting a facility pass will be required to show proof of residency (i.e. Drivers License with a Providence address or school ID along with report card verifying address)

Passes are \$5.00 each and tennis courts keys are \$15.00 each.

May 28-29

May 30 (Splash Day)

The pool will open for regular pool season on June 4th, 2016.
