PROVIDENCE TENNIS COURT RULES

- 1. Courts are for Providence residents and their Guests only. A resident must accompany guests. For safety reasons, children age 9 and under must be accompanied by a person at least 16 years of age.
- 2. Only one court may be used at a time by a resident and their Guest(s).
- 3. All courts in use must have a name and valid facility pass number on the sign-up sheet.
- 4. Facility passes must be <u>displayed</u>. If you do not have a valid facility pass you can be asked to leave the courts.
- 5. Courts may be reserved by using the sign-up sheet. Reserved courts are forfeited if the resident does not show up within 10 minutes of the reserved time. If you have not signed the reservation sheet, you may be asked to leave by new arrivals who have signed up for a court.
- 6. Playing time is limited to:

One (1) hour for an individual or lessons

One and one half $(1 \ 1/2)$ hour for singles

Two (2) hours for doubles.

- 7. League play reservations must be approved by the PCA Board and be posted 2 weeks in advance per season. Only 2 courts may be used.
- 8. Tennis shoes must be worn on the courts. No other shoes are allowed.
- 9. No non-tennis playing children are allowed on the courts for their own safety.
- 10. No skateboards, bicycles, roller skates, roller blades, pets or glass containers are allowed on the courts. The tennis courts are for tennis only.

Please make sure the gates are locked when you leave. Tennis Court Hours: 6:00 a.m. To 10:00 p.m.

Stanbridge Park - Rules & Regulations

- This park is for Providence residents and their guests only, others are trespassing.
- Park hours are dawn to dusk.
- Parents are solely responsible for the safety of their children while in the playground.
- No pets, skateboards, or bicycles allowed in park.
- Do not climb on outside of tube, slide or walk up the slides.
- Slide feet first only.
- Do not jump from swings or off the top of the play equipment.
- Please pick up trash keep our park clean!
- No alcohol, no glass containers.
- Be courteous, play safely and have fun.
